

Privacy and Cookies

This policy sets out the personal information that we gather about you when you visit our website, how we may use that information and who we may share it with. Auto Prep LTD are committed to safeguarding and preserving the privacy of our visitors and we will update this policy from time to time so please do review this policy regularly.

What information do we collect?

We collect only general data relating to how our website is used. This includes information concerning the number of visitors to our website, the pages our visitors come from and which pages they view. This data does not personally identify you to us or any other party and is purely used to aid us in our market research.

We will only collect any information about you, from which you could be identified, with your consent.

How do we this information?
